

# Fire Action Plan

1. Take **EVERYONE** into account - Elderly, Disabled & Children.
2. Choose the best escape route for when you're in bed and an alternative one should it be cut off - keep them **CLEAR** at all times.
3. Tell everyone where the door & window keys are; if you can't escape its safer to stay in your home, **PROTECT** yourself, and wait to be rescued.

Here we have an example of an 'action plan' with all escape routes marked as red arrows.

Develop an escape plan by drawing a floor plan of your residence. Next use a coloured pen to draw a broken line charting at least two escape routes from each room. Finally, mark a place outside of the home where household members should meet in case of emergency.
