# Warning about: Sale of Washing Machines and TVs.

### Background

Officers from Warrington Trading Standards and Cheshire Police are warning people to be on their guard following a report that two men were attempting to sell a washing machine from the back of a van. One man claimed to have been attending an interview at Martin Dawes and that he had been given the machine following the interview. The man has no connection with the company.

### Warning

Trading Standards and the Police are keen to speak to anyone who has purchased or been offered similar goods in such circumstances. There is no evidence at this stage that the items are stolen.
