Warning about: Bonfire & Firework Incidents

Background

Warrington Trading Standards Officers have been made aware by Cheshire Fire & Rescue Service of a number of reported unauthorised bonfires. Incidents have occurred at several locations in the Borough where fires have been ignited.

Fire Officers have reported that wheelie bins are also being targeted and advise that bins should be put out only on the morning of collection and once emptied, removed as soon as possible and stored in a safe place.

Trading Standards have seized a quantity of fireworks following a report that they were being sold from a house in Warrington. If you have been offered fireworks or are aware of any sales from vehicles or private houses please contact **Trading Standards on 08454 040506**
