



Warning: Phishing Email - PayPal

Background

It has been brought to the attention of Warrington and Halton Trading Standards that a scam email appearing to come from PayPal is in circulation.

Please do not respond in anyway to this email. Never provide any information. Never click on any link that seems suspicious. Remember, when it comes to phishing, you are in control.

To protect your personal financial information, ignore the requests in the email. Forward the entire email to spoof@paypal.com Do not alter the subject line or forward the message as an attachment. Now delete the suspicious email from your email account.

Please be aware, the more an email is broadcast the more likely it is to receive junk, spam, phishing and other malicious communications.
